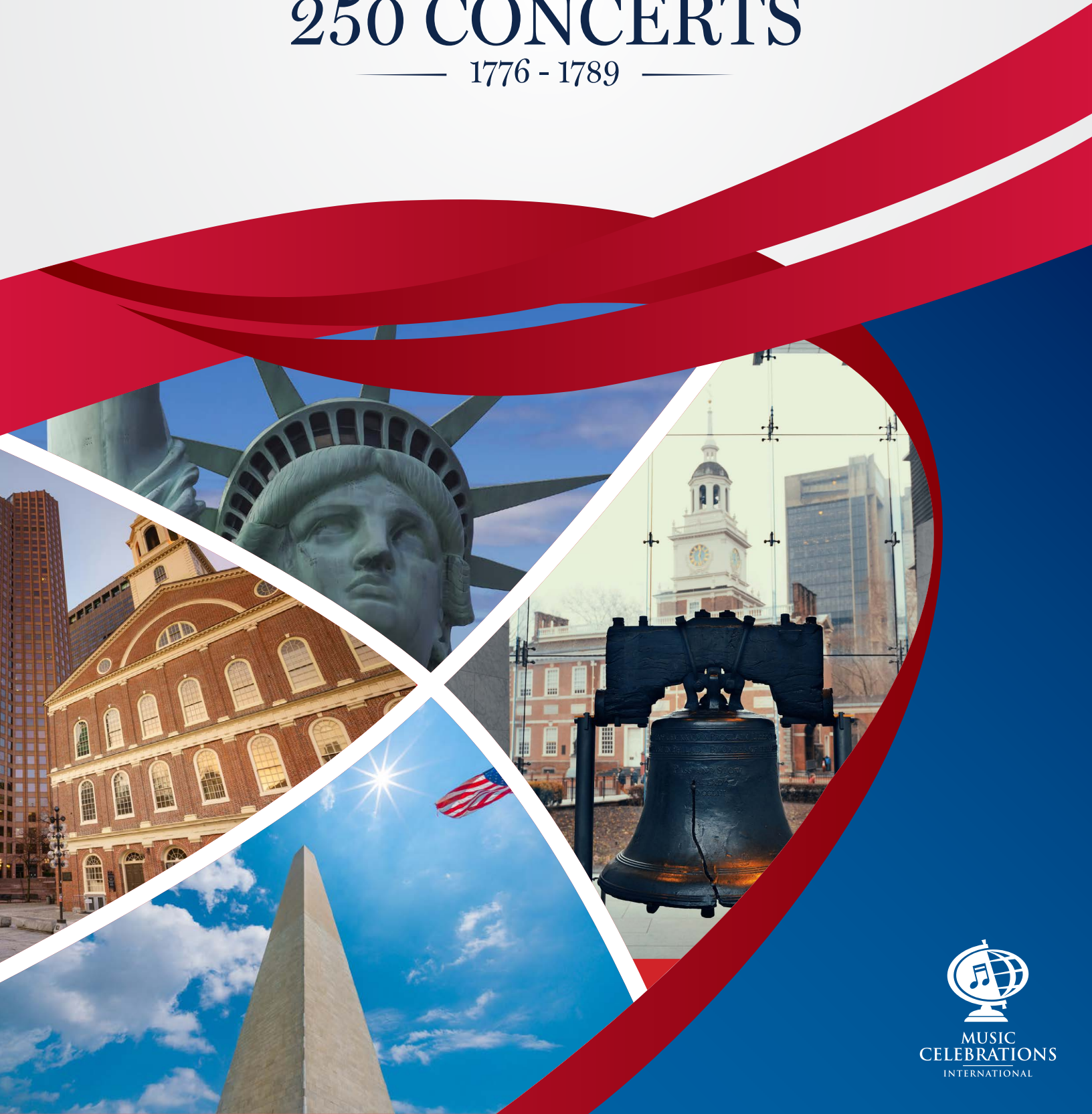

In 2026, 250 Concerts celebrated America's 250th birthday, with performances and festivals in four iconic American cities—Boston, New York, Philadelphia, and Washington, DC. The celebration did not end in 2026—it continues into a new chapter in America's history. 250 Concerts continues to bring ensembles together to celebrate the nation through performance, cultural discovery, and shared musical experiences leading up to the 250th anniversary of George Washington being sworn in as the first President of the United States of America in 1789.



BOSTON

Boston is known as the birthplace of the American Revolution. Walk the Freedom Trail, a 2.5-mile-long path that weaves through 16 historical sites, including the Massachusetts State House and the home of Paul Revere. From its celebrated symbols of patriotism to its undiscovered neighborhoods, the sights and sounds of the nation's revolutionary birthplace inspire millions of visitors every year.



NEW YORK CITY

New York City is a melting pot of cultures and a symbol of American resilience. In 1789, George Washington was inaugurated as president here at Federal Hall. Explore Ellis Island and the Statue of Liberty, both powerful symbols of freedom and the immigrant experience. Marvel at the skyscrapers of Manhattan, take a stroll through Central Park, and experience the vibrant energy of Times Square.



PHILADELPHIA

Philadelphia is where the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution were born. Visit Independence Hall and the Liberty Bell, iconic symbols of American democracy. The city's historic district is a treasure trove of colonial-era architecture and museums that will transport you back to the days of the nation's founding.



WASHINGTON, DC

Washington, DC is now the heart of the United States. Explore the National Mall, flanked by the Washington Monument, U.S. Capitol, Lincoln Memorial, and numerous monuments and memorials. Get a taste of American history in the world-famous Smithsonian museums, showcasing the nation's diverse history and culture.

From the founding cities of the American Revolution to the places that have shaped the nation ever since, each concert and tour becomes part of a larger musical journey—one that looks back with appreciation, celebrates the present, and looks ahead to the future.
